

Online Safety Policy

Online lessons

It is important that the highest standards are adhered to by both the teaching team and students when conducting online lessons:

- Be aware of your setting – work in an appropriate place with a suitable background.
- Dress appropriately – like you would for a classroom lesson.
- Be punctual for the lessons – get set up well in advance to avoid technological issues.
- Make sure the device you are using is either plugged in or has sufficient battery life.
- Have all the necessary paperwork and equipment to hand for your lesson

Internet use in the classroom

We recognise the importance of appropriate filtering and monitoring to keep children safe online in our classroom. To this end:

- Children in KS1 and KS2 may only access the internet under one-to-one supervision from their teacher during a lesson
- Children in KS3 and above may only access the internet in a lesson or during a private study period with either one to one supervision, or with regular monitoring by a teacher or the classroom manager.
- SafeSearch filtering is used at the highest level on all classroom laptops
